

P1 Stationery List for September 2020

- Plastic box/lunchbox for holding individual items – labelled on the top and bottom with your child's name – make sure they can open and close it by themselves.
- Writing pencils, eg, starter pencils – usually thicker and triangular shaped
- 43g Pritt Stick glue
- Pencil sharpener
- Rubber
- Box of crayons (good variety of colours)
- Packet of colouring pencils
- Packet of felt pens/markers
- Small tub of playdough – labelled with child's name
- Paintbrush - zip-lock bag for carrying home wet paintbrushes
- Sticky post-it notes (square) for Phonics work – will need at least 2
- Pair of scissors – left or right-handed, depending on which your child needs
- Waterproof apron or man's old short-sleeved shirt – for Art and messy activities

Everyone will need a change of underwear, socks, uniform and footwear (black plimsoles fine and these can also be used for PE) in their bag, in case of toilet accidents.

Also - Flushable Baby wipes and tissues (in addition to normal sanitising wipes and gel) for toilet incidents.

School bag/backpack will need to be large enough to hold the stationery box, homework folder, spare clothing, wipes and preferably lunchbox and drinks bottle (No keyrings or additional hanging items on schoolbags please).

- P1 will not be initially changing into a PE Kit in school due to social distancing restrictions but we would like them to have black plimsoles to change into when required. Hopefully we will use the PE Kit later in the school year.
- **All items need to be labelled with your child's name, using a permanent pen.**
- **Thank you for your help in providing these items for individual use in school. This will help us to comply with COVID 19 Safety requirements.**
